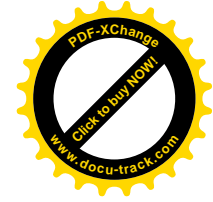
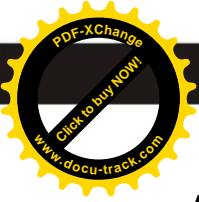
Key learning points that the intern might obtain during the internship:

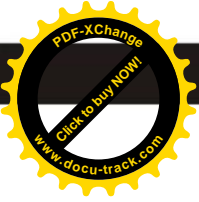

Job/Task Description 1: Selection and designing of recreational activities (games, arts and crafts, readings...) for children to play during the rest time (after lunch) in the library.

Job/Task Description 2: Assistant Teacher for English classes, Story telling for children. Taking part of the pedagogical weekly meetings with the staff. Taking part of the monthly events.

Job/Task Description 3: Having individual meetings with the pedagogical coordinator in order to help the trainee with their work.

Job/Task Description 4: Getting in touch with parents and watching the students during the arrival, break and leaving of the school day.

Job/Task Description 5: The trainee may also do other activities, like plays or helping the teachers from Pre-school and/or Elementary School. The main purpose of this job is to focus on the children's learning process.
