3. Internet Access provided

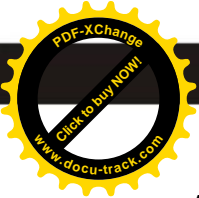
Measurable results expected from the intern: The discussions with the kids at school and the possible solutions made together with the kids.
