Department: Education

Job/Task Description: The intern will make presentations and discussions during school lessons (45 minutes per lesson) in particular topics. There are obligatory and optional topics as well.

Obligatory topics:

1. Intern's culture (Language, thinking, etiquette, economy, history, education, tourism)
2. Global warming (Conditions, causes, influence temp. changes, water + air pollution effects)
3. Health Issues (Healthcare systems, starvation-obesity, AIDS/HIV, diseases, effects of smoking, drugs consumption)
4. Racism (Racial and ethnic discrimination, ethnic conflicts, cultural understanding)

Optional topics (2 at least):

1. Global financial crisis (Background, impacts on financial institutions & global economy, responses)
2. Hunger & Poverty (Starvation, stats, causes, solutions)
3. Human rights (Regional human rights (Africa, Americas, Asia, Europe, Oceania), violations)
4. Overpopulation (Growth statistics, projections, capacity of earth, resources, ecological footprint of regions, effects)
5. Water crisis (Resources, health impacts, oceans' desalination, solutions)

Details of the working conditions:

1. Personal Workspace provided
2. Computer provided
3. Internet Access provided
4. Other Conditions: Accommodation and food three times a day.

Measurable results expected from the inter: Making successful presentations and involving the students to actively participate in the program. Completing responsibilities on time, respecting the rules of the school.

Planning and organizing lectures - Teaching and facilitating skills - Leadership skills - Presentation skills - Getting to know a different culture

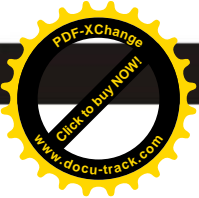

Measurable results expected from the intern: To prepare and deliver to high schools students (100) trainings and workshops with other 2 interns and organizing cultural events.

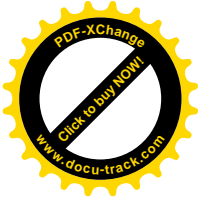
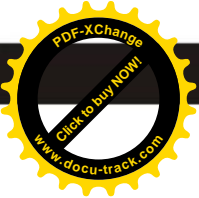

Measurable results expected from the intern: Conduct a minimum of twenty workshops within a two-month period, and a target audience of 50 attendance.

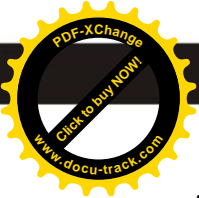
Key learning points that the intern might obtain during the internship:
