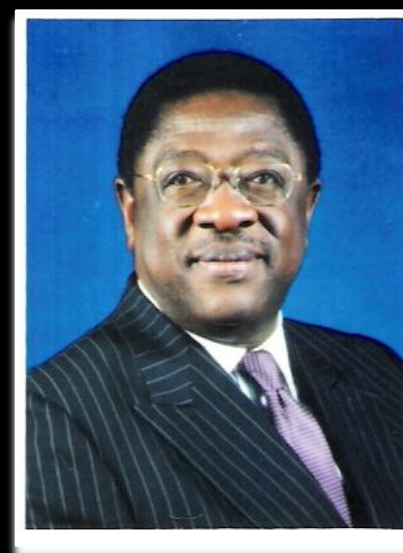

Currently, the Attorney General since 13th May 1991- he is the principal Legal Adviser to the Government.

He got long career full of incredible achievements and recognitions.

He oversaw the transition from one party state to a multiparty democracy in Kenya (December 1991) and from one Government to another through a free and fair election in which the ruling (KANU) was defeated by the opposition (NARC)

(December 2002).

He drafted the proposed new Constitution of Kenya based on the Constitution of Kenya Bill as drafted by the National Constitutional Conference and as amended by Parliament.

"Amos Wako first engaged with AIIESEC in 1994 when he accepted to be patron of African Congress held in Kenya in the same year. The Congress had a very successful Human Rights Symposium. Human Rights then was a very tricky subject in Kenya. As patron, he mentioned AIIESEC and young people in engaging and becoming aware of Human Rights as a sustainability issue for business and society. He has gone ahead to host luncheons to inspire AIIESEC ever since. Hon. Amos Wako is therefore a hero for AIIESEC and a strong role model for youth in East Africa."

In 1993 he was appointed member of the International Advisory Panel of the Robert F.

Kennedy Memorial Human Rights Award.

By 2005 he was appointed President of the Asian African Legal Consultative Organisation which has observed status with U.N.O.
